

ORDINANCE No. 118

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE PENNSYLVANIA SEWAGE FACILITIES ACT IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD, COUNTY OF BUTLER.

WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act of January 24, 1966, P. L. 1535 provides that the provisions thereof shall be administered by the local municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Winfield Township, Butler County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. That the provisions of the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act of January 24, 1966, P. L. 1535, and its amendments are hereby ordained to apply to all new sewage or septic installations in Winfield Township, Butler County, Pennsylvania, together with all rules and regulations issued pursuant thereto.

2. No person shall install an individual or community sewage disposal system or construct any building in Winfield Township, Butler County, Pennsylvania, in which an individual or community sewage disposal system is to be installed without first obtaining a permit indicating that the site, plans, and specifications of such system are in compliance with the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act and the rules and regulations adopted pursuant thereto.

3. This Ordinance shall become effective five days after it is adopted.
