

WINFIELD TOWNSHIP  
BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
ORDINANCE # 189

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING AND REGULATING THE  
WEIGHT OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON TOWNSHIP ROAD  
T-679, COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS BROSE ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE Board of Supervisors of  
Winfield Township, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and  
enacted by the authority of the same;

SECTION I: This ordinance shall be known and may be cited  
as "Motor Vehicle Size, Weight and Load Limitations Ordinance of the Township  
of Winfield".

SECTION II: This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the  
authority conferred by the "Vehicle Code", Act of 1976, June 17, P. L. 162,  
No. 81 § 1, effective July 1, 1977 (75 PA. C.S. A. § 101 et. seq.) as amended.

SECTION III: It is deemed beneficial to the Township of  
Winfield that a weight limit of ten (10) ton be imposed on the following road  
located within Winfield Township:

T-679, commonly referred to as Brose Road.

SECTION IV: All appropriate signs listing said weight  
limit shall be displayed according to the general weight limit ordinance  
(Ordinance #187) of the Township of Winfield.

SECTION V: Any person operating a motor vehicle or  
combination upon this road in violation of the prohibition or restriction  
imposed under Section III is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon  
conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$75, except that any person convicted  
of operating a vehicle with a gross weight in excess of a posted weight shall,  
upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$150 plus \$150 for each 500  
pounds, or part hereof, in excess of 3,000 pounds over the maximum allowable  
weight.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall go into effect five (5)  
days after its enactment or adoption.
