

WINFIELD TOWNSHIP
BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. 196

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING, REGULATING AND RESTRICTING SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON TOWNSHIP ROADS KNOWN AS JONES ROAD, COBHAM LANE AND CHAPELVIEW DRIVE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Winfield Township, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I: It is deemed beneficial to the Township of Winfield, and the peace, safety, and welfare of the residents thereof that speed limits be retained by the Township of Winfield as follows:

- (A) Township Road T577, commonly known as Jones Road,
35 Miles Per Hour
- (B) Township Road T780, commonly known as Cobham Lane,
25 Miles Per Hour
- (C) Township Road T950, commonly known as Chapelview Drive,
25 Miles Per Hour

SECTION II: All appropriate signs listing said speed limits shall be displayed according to the general speed regulation ordinance (Ordinance #781) of the Township of Winfield.

SECTION III: Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon summary conviction thereof before any District Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and cost of prosecution for each offense, the same to be for the use of the Township of Winfield and to be collected as fines and penalties are now by law collectible.

Ordinance #196:

SECTION IV: This ordinance shall go into effect five (5) days after its enactment or adoption.
