

WINFIELD TOWNSHIP  
BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
ORDINANCE NO. 287

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING, REGULATING, AND  
RESTRICTING SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON  
TOWNSHIP ROAD #T749, COMMONLY REFERRED  
TO AS BECKER ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of  
Winfield Township, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained  
and enacted by the authority of the same;

SECTION I. It is deemed beneficial to the Township of Winfield,  
and the peace, safety, and welfare of the residents thereof that a speed limit  
be imposed on the following road located within Winfield Township:

#T749, commonly referred to as Becker Road.

SECTION II. It is deemed appropriate for the safety of the  
residents that the speed limit on the above-named township road be twenty-  
five (25) miles per hour. All appropriate signs listing said speed limit  
shall be displayed according to the general speed regulation ordinance  
(Ordinance #781) of the Township of Winfield.

SECTION III. Any person violating any of the provisions of  
this ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof before any District  
Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of Ten (\$10.00) dollars and cost of  
prosecution for each offense, the same to be for the use of the Township of  
Winfield and to be collected as fines and penalties are now by law collectible.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall go into effect five (5) days  
after its enactment or adoption.
