

WINFIELD TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE #297

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PARK AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Winfield Township, Butler County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that:

- SECTION 1: The purpose of the Park and Recreation Advisory Board shall be to provide advice to and consult with the Board of Supervisors of Winfield Township on matters concerning parks and recreation.
- SECTION 2: The members of the Park and Recreation Advisory Board shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of Winfield Township.
- SECTION 3: The members of the Park and Recreation Advisory Board shall consist of five (5) residents of Winfield Township.
- SECTION 4: The members of the Park and Recreation Advisory Board shall serve for terms of five years or until their successors are appointed, except that the members first appointed shall be appointed so that the terms of not more than two members expire annually.
- SECTION 5: Members shall serve without pay but may be reimbursed for all expenses incurred in performing their duties.
- SECTION 6: All persons appointed shall serve their full terms unless voluntarily resigned or removed by the Board of Supervisors for dereliction or neglect of duty. Vacancies occurring other than by expiration of term shall be for the unexpired term and shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments.
- SECTION 7: The members of the Park and Recreation Advisory Board shall elect a chairman and secretary and select all other necessary officers to serve for a

period of one year. The Board may adopt rules and regulations for the conduct of all business within its jurisdiction and exercise powers and functions concerning parks and recreation facilities as may be delegated to it by the Board of Supervisors. The Park and Recreation Advisory Board shall submit an annual report to the Board of Supervisors, including an analysis of the adequacy and effectiveness of community recreation areas, facilities and leadership.

SECTION 8: This ordinance is passed under authority of the Second Class Code, Article XXII, Section 2204.

SECTION 9: The sections and parts of sections included in this ordinance are hereby declared to be independent sections and parts of sections. If any such section or part of section shall be held invalid, such holding shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance, nor the context in which such part of section so held invalid may appear.

SECTION 10: This ordinance shall become effective five days after its adoption.
