ORDINANCE NO. 681-B

AN ORDINANCE OF WINFIELD TOWNSHIP AMENDING THE JUNKYARD  
ORDINANCE OF AUGUST 27, 1981 (ORDINANCE NO. 681);

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Winfield  
Township, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the  
authority of the same as provided for in Section 702 the Act of May 1, 1933, P.L. Law 103, as  
amended.

SECTION I of the August 27, 1981, ordinance is amended as follows:

SECTION I: Definition

- a. A "junkyard", for purposes of this Ordinance, shall be considered any out-  
door area of any property on which more than two (2) motor vehicles not in  
operating condition or without current license plates are located, or any area  
of any property exceeding seven hundred fifty (750) square feet on the  
ground used for storing or collecting discarded household appliances or other  
used material.
- b. Vehicles stored within a structure and farm equipment stored outside on a  
working farm shall be excluded from this definition. The term "inspector"  
means the Board of Township Supervisors as a group or any of them or an  
officially designated agent acting individually as authorized by the Board.
