

ORDINANCE NO. 881

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING, REGULATING, AND RESTRICTING SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON TOWNSHIP ROADS #T620 AND #T618, COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS STONEY HOLLOW ROAD AND BICKER ROAD, RESPECTIVELY.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Winfield Township, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same;

SECTION I. It is deemed beneficial to the Township of Winfield, and the peace, safety, and welfare of the residents thereof that speed limits be imposed on the following roads within the Township of Winfield:

- (A). Township Road #620, commonly referred to as Stoney Hollow Road, and
- (B). Township Road #618, commonly referred to as Bicker Road.

SECTION II. It is deemed appropriate for the safety of the residents that the speed limit on the above-named township roads be thirty-five (35) miles per hour. All appropriate signs listing said speed limits shall be displayed according to the general speed regulation ordinance (ordinance # 781) of the Township of Winfield.

SECTION IV. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof before any District Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution for each offense, the same to be for the use of the Township of Winfield and to be collected as fines and penalties are now by law collectible.

SECTION V. This ordinance shall go into effect five (5) days after its enactment or adoption.
