## ORDINANCE NO. 1-79

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO VACATE PART OF A ROAD WHOLLY WITHIN WINFIELD TOWNSHIP, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, HEREINAFTER DESIGNATED AS BEING A PART OF TOWNSHIP ROAD 761.

The Township Supervisors of the Township of Winfield, Butler County, Pennsylvania, do hereby ordain as follows:

Τ

That the said road hereinafter described no longer serves the general public in that a parallel road has been provided in the near vicinity.

II

That the Township Supervisors of Winfield Township,
Butler County, Pennsylvania, have determined that in their judgment
the following described section of township road shall be vacated
and abandoned as a Township road under the authority of Section 1101
of the Second Class Township Code; 53 P.S. 66101 as amended.

III

That the said abandonment is necessary for the public convenience and is in the best interests of the public welfare of the citizens of Winfield Township and the general public.

ΙV

That ten days written notice has been given to the property owners affected by the abandonment of said portion of road of the time and place when and where all parties interested may meet, be heard, and summon witnesses; moreover, that the provisions of the ordinance have been advertised in the proper manner according to law.

That pursuant to the Supervisor's judgment referred to in II above, the Township of Winfield does hereby vacate the following tract of road:

From L.R. 10037 (S.L.D. Sta. 5 + 00) Southwest to a Point. Being approximately 0.12 mile (634 L.F.) in length.

VΤ

That upon abandonment of the above described portion of the township road, it shall revert to the former owner, Penn-Dixie Industries, Incorporated.

VII

The Township Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance in the Clerk of Courts Office together with the survey and the Secretary of the Township is hereby directed to file immediately after enactment of this ordinance a draft of the overlay with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation in Indiana, Pennsylvania.
