## ORDINANCE NO. 185

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING, REGULATING AND RESTRICTING SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON TOWNSHIP ROADS KNOWN AS BEAR CREEK ROAD, MARWOOD ROAD, AND IRON BRIDGE ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Winfield Township, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I: It is deemed beneficial to the Township of Winfield, and the peace, safety, and welfare of the residents thereof that speed limits be retained by the Township of Winfield as follows:

- (A) Township Road #841, Bear Creek Road (formerly Appl. 3875)

  Station 0+00 to Station 124+42 -- 45 M.P.H. both sides
- (B) Township Road #844, Iron Bridge Road (formerly L.R. 10138)

  Station 1+40 to Station 29+23 -- 35 M.P.H. both sides
  Station 0+00 to Station 1+40 -- 45 M.P.H. both sides
- (C) Township Road #846, Marwood Road (formerly L.R. 10031)

  Station 80+00 to Station 108+77 -- 35 M.P.H. both sides

SECTION II: All appropriate signs listing said speed limits shall be displayed according to the general speed regulation ordinance (Ord. #781) of the Township of Winfield.

SECTION III: Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon summary conviction thereof before any District Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution for each offense, the same to be for the use of the Township of Winfield and to be collected as fines and penalties are now by law collectible.

SECTION IV: This ordinance shall go into effect five (5) days after its enactment or adoption.
