## ordinance no. 2-79

AN ORDINANCE OF WINFIELD TOWNSHIP REQUIRING PROPERTY OWNERS TO FURNISH THE NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF ALL TENANTS AND OCCUPANTS OF RENTAL PROPERTY TO THE TOWNSHIP WITHIN SEVEN (7) DAYS OF OCCUPANCY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Township of Winfield, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section I: All owners or operators of rental income property within the Township of Winfield shall furnish to the Township a written list setting forth the names and addresses of all tenants or occupants of said property or apartments within thirty (30) days from the effective date hereof.

Section II: It shall be the duty of all owners or operators of rental income property to keep said list current and to furnish a revised list in writing to the Township of Winfield setting forth any change in occupancy within seven (7) days thereof.

Section III: Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate the terms or provisions of this Ordinance shall after conviction in a summary proceeding be fined \$25.00 for each violation thereof.
