AN ORDINANCE LIMITING, REGULATING, AND RESTRICTING SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON ALL TOWNSHIP ROADS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF WINFIELD TOWNSHIP BUTIER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND PROVIDING FOR THE DIRECTION OF OFFICIAL SIGNS ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE HIGHWAY FACING THE TRAFFIC TO BE CONTROLLED, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

FE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Winfield Township, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same;

SECTION I. It is deemed beneficial to the Township of Winfield, and the peace, safety, and welfare of the residents thereof that speed limits be imposed upon the Township roads within the Township of Winfield.

SECTION II. All Township roads within the limits of Winfield Township shall be limited as to the operation of motor vehicles, except those restricted by the Motor Vehicle Code to lower maximum speed, to speeds to be designated by official signs placed on such highways.

SECTION III. Official signs erected by the Board of Supervisors on the right hand side of the highway facing the traffic to be controlled shall be displayed, which said speed limit so displayed shall be observed for a distance beyond said signs for not more than one-eighth (1/8) of a mile. Additional signs shall be placed at intervals not greater than one-eighth (1/8) of a mile, and at the end of such limited speed zone, official signs shall be erected indicating the end of such limited speed zone.

SECTION IV. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinarce of the upon summary or relations thereof before any District

Magistuate. For each offense, the same to be for the use of the Township of Winfield and to be collected as fines and penalties are now by law collectible.

SECTION V. This ordinance shall go into effect five (5) days after its enactment or adoption.
